Those who held active membership at the time of retirement. Retirement = accepted for retirement by SERS, STRS or PERS, and no longer employed full-time by an Ohio Board of Education. Retired-rehired SBOs serving as treasurer/CFO, business manager or similar function are not eligible for this membership type.	Awarded at the Annual Workshop to persons who may be so honored by the OASBO Board of Directors	Awarded at the Annual Workshop to past state presidents who have announced their intention to retire from the school business field within the year, or if they will no longer be employed full-time in an SBO position.
